### **ABOUT BATTLE CREEK OUTDOOR EDUCATION CENTER**

The Outdoor Education Center (OEC), commonly called 'Clear Lake Camp', is a division of the Battle Creek Public School System (BCPS). We are located on Clear Lake in Dowling, Michigan. We offer a serene rural environment less than an hour's drive from Lansing, Grand Rapids, and Kalamazoo.

As the oldest school camp in the nation, we have been offering programs to supplement school curriculum for over 60 years. We currently offer overnight and day programs to schools located across southern Michigan. In addition, we host weddings, family retreats, and workshops.

### **COORDINATOR POSITION**

The Program Coordinator plays an essential role in the camp experience for visiting schools. The Coordinator is responsible for the day-to-day operations related to school visits, seasonal instructor staff, instructional programming and supporting equipment, and communications with visiting schools.

### **WORKING CONDITIONS**

Programs are run in all weather conditions, the program coordinator needs to be able to work outdoors for long hours in cold, heat, rain, snow, and other weather that arises. The program coordinator will also need to be able to stand for hours and be able to hike up to 5 miles. Should be able to lift or move up to 25 pounds.
