OEC Camper: The following code of conduct explains the Outdoor Education Center's (OEC) behavior expectations and the consequences for not following the code. Please read the code of conduct. Signing this code is a contract. It means that you agree to follow it and accept the consequences for not following it.

Parent/Guardian: Please read the following, code of conduct. Please sign the bottom of this form to show your intent to support the implementation of this Code of Conduct in regards to your child.

As a student attending the OEC, I understand that:

- I will be expected to participate in all aspects of the camp program and follow the daily camp schedule.
- I will conduct myself with respect toward instructors, teachers, and other students so that I myself may be respected.
- I understand that the OEC has the same expectations of my behavior that my school has of me. My choices at camp may result in consequences at school as well.
- The OEC has a discipline policy as follows. I will be warned about unacceptable behavior. If I receive four written warnings, I will be dismissed from camp. Some unacceptable behaviors may warrant immediate dismissal. (The parent handbook has details of this policy.)
- I am fully responsible for my choices/actions while at camp. If I reach a level 4 written warning, I will be dismissed from camp and my parent or guardian will be responsible for my transportation home from camp and my camp fee will not be reimbursed.

Failure to meet these standards will result in these steps:

- Written warnings for each incidence of warranted unacceptable behavior.
- At a level 3 written warning, a call will be made to my parent /guardian /principal.
- At a level 4 written warning, a call will be made to my parent/guardian to arrange my ride home.
