

## OEC Residential School Camp Rates Updated September 2023

Per student camp price includes meals for students and up to 2 adults per class from lunch on arrival day through lunch on departure day, overnight lodging for students and teachers, 24 hour camp staff supervision, and 24 hour health officer.

Schools must provide at least 1 teacher or other school personnel per class who will attend the full activities, morning, afternoon, and evening as well as meals with the students. Schools choosing to bring more than 2 adults per class may incur additional charges. There must be at least one adult school representative on site at all times, including evening and overnight. Schools must have at least one vehicle on site in case of an emergency.

- 5 day/4 night residential camp: \$470 per student
- 4 day/3 night residential camp: \$390 per student
- 3 day/2 night residential camp: \$325 per student
- 2 day/1 night residential camp: \$275 per student

Prorating will occur for students sent home due to illness. Prorating will <u>not</u> occur for students sent home because of disciplinary reasons or students arriving late/departing early by parent choice, i.e. sports events, appointments, vacation, homesickness.

High Ropes Course, Climbing Tower, Remotely Operated Vehicles (ROV), and Canoeing activities can be selected at no additional cost as long as students meet grade requirements and scheduling requirements are met.

At no additional cost, a camp representative can give a presentation at your school for students, for parents, or for both. The presentation includes a PowerPoint presentation with photos of the dorms, lodge, dining hall, and activities. Each presentation, whether for students or for parents, takes about an hour or more. The camp representative will also meet separately with teachers to plan details of your camp trip.
